Trail Day Trips - Fun, Unique, Family Friendly – about a dozen trails that are low on difficulty but way up there on fun and history. Description - A group of easy walking trails, each with something special to discover. No special equipment is needed, and some are handicapped accessible.

Upper Peninsula Road Trip – this program will include SOME well-known destinations but will FEATURE many lesser-known attractions that many people miss. The trip includes Bonanza Falls in the west, Lakeneland Junk Art Park, the Face on the Cliff, and Iroquois Point in the east, among many others.

Michigan Day Trips – this program will be similar to Michigan Rediscovered but will be new destinations and a focus on family friendly attractions. Some will be mostly for children. Places like the Dinosaur Gardens, Alligator Sanctuary and wild bears at the Konteka.

These existing programs are continued by popular demand.

Michigan Rediscovered - Adventures on the back roads. A rollicking road trip across Michigan to more than a dozen destinations most travelers have missed. Discover the underground rathskeller in the Irish Hills, the gravity mystery in Frankfort, the Monarch Butterfly Migration, Lady Godiva in Michigan and others.

Oddities & Rarities – We explore strange objects and mysteries. Learn about the enigmatic Keweenaw Wall, the ancient artifact in Nahma, the Tomb of the Cow, the Sanilac Petroglyphs and more. A very popular program with an emphasis on forgotten Michigan history.
